### STATEMENT OF THE CASE

1. Arrington has the right to drill and develop the oil and gas minerals from the surface to the base of the Morrow formation underlying the NW/4 of Section 26, T18S, R24E, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

2. This well is located within one mile of the pools described above.

3. Arrington has proposed this well at an unorthodox well location to Nearburg Exploration Company, L.L.C.

4. Arrington is in the process of obtaining a written voluntary agreement from Nearburg Exploration Company, L.L.C. and hopes to have the matter finalized by the time of the hearing so that the compulsory pooling portion of the case can be dismissed.

5. The unorthodox well location is the optimum location within the N/2 spacing unit in which to locate a well to test for Cisco and/or Morrow production.
