Dear Ms. Wrotenbery;

By Order No. R-11526, the Oil Conservation Division granted the application of Penwell Energy, Inc. and adopted Temporary Pool Rules and Regulations for the Arena Blanca-Entrada Pool. Since the adoption of these rules, Penwell has been attempting to get electrical power to the field but to date has been unable to get the Jemez Mountain Electric Cooperative to extent the needed power line. Accordingly, no activity has occurred since the temporary rules were adopted.

Penwell plans to proceed with its plans for the pool but cannot provide the Division with a date when this activity will occur. Penwell therefore requests that Case 12540, which is scheduled for hearing on April 18, 2002, be continued indefinitely. As soon as power is extended to the pool, Penwell will notify the Division and request that this case be placed on the next available examiner hearing docket.
