Dear Mr. Examiner:

Southwest Royalties, Inc. and its co-interest owners are the owners of the working interest leasehold estate under that certain Oil and Gas Lease between the State of New Mexico, as Lessor, and Francis C. Wilson, as Lessee, dated December 10, 1936, bearing Lease No. B-6807 insofar as the same covers 120 acres in the SE/4 Sec. 13, T21S, R34E, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico, those 120 acres being described as the NW/4SE/4 and S2SE/4 of said Section 13, below the depth of 5200 ft. The leasehold rights above that depth of 5200 ft. in those 120 acres were previously owned by Southwest Royalties, but assigned to Parks & Luttrell, Inc., effective May 1, 1998. It is the writer's understanding that those rights so assigned by Southwest Royalties to Parks & Luttrell are now owned by DelMar Holdings, LP, which may or may not assert some claim to Southwest Royalties deep rights.

The writer recognizes that the Division is not the proper forum to resolve a title problem, if any there be in this instance.

Please be advised that Southwest Royalties asserts no interest in the shallow rights above 5200 ft. in the described 120 acres, and that it is willing to join in Matador Petroleum's proposed well so long as there be some provisions in the Operating Agreement to divide the costs and expenses of drilling, testing and completing its Laura State "13" Com No. 2 Well, as well as insure that the production from the different depths is properly paid to the owner thereof.
