#### STATEMENT OF THE CASE

1. Chesapeake has the right to drill and develop the oil and gas minerals from the surface to the base of the Strawn formation underlying the S/2NE/4 of Section 5, T17S, R37E, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

2. This well is subject to the special rules for the Shipp-Strawn Pool which provide for standard 80-acre spacing unit with well to be located within 150 feet of the center of a governmental quarter-quarter section.

3. This unorthodox well location is necessary due to geologic reasons in order to provide the optimum location within this spacing unit to locate this well.
