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## REPORTER'S CERTIFICATE

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WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at 1 2 2:57 p.m.: EXAMINER CATANACH: All right, at this time I 3 will call Case 12,604, which is in the matter of the 4 5 hearing called by the Oil Conservation Division for an order creating and extending certain pools in Rio Arriba 6 7 and San Juan Counties, New Mexico. This case is styled such that in the absence of 8 9 objection it will be taken under advisement. 10 However, we have a special guest here today, Mr. 11 Steve Hayden, who is the geologist in the District 3 Aztec 12 Office, and I believe that Mr. Hayden will provide some 13 additional testimony on this case today. So I will ask Steve Hayden to please stand to be 14 sworn in at this time. 15 16 (Thereupon, the witness was sworn.) 17 STEVE HAYDEN, the witness herein, after having been first duly sworn upon 18 19 his oath, was examined and testified as follows: DIRECT EXAMINATION 20 21 BY EXAMINER CATANACH: 22 Mr. Hayden --Q. Yes, sir. 23 Α. -- have you ever testified before the New Mexico 24 Q. 25 Oil Conservation Division previously?

A. No, sir, I haven't.

- Q. Would you briefly state your educational and work background?
- A. Well, I was educated at the University of New Mexico in geology. I have a work background in exploration with both field things, including drilling and mud engineering and geology that goes back to 1968. I've been employed at the OCD in Aztec for 11 months now as the District Geologist.
- Q. Okay, thank you, Mr. Hayden. I would qualify Mr. Hayden as an expert in geological matters.

And I believe that you do have a change that you propose to make to the nomenclature case today, Mr. Hayden?

- A. Yes, sir. On article (b), the second creation, was a Bisti-Fruitland Sand-Pictured Cliffs Pool --
  - Q. -- Uh-huh.
- A. -- I would like to change that to just a Pictured Cliffs pool.

The well that it was based on, the Fruitland production, was reassigned to the Basin-Fruitland Coal recently, and so the Fruitland sand is not productive in this interval.

Q. As I now read your proposal, the new gas pool that would be created in Section 2, comprising the north half and southwest quarter --

Actually, it's the next one down --1 Α. 2 Q. I'm sorry. -- in Section 5, northeast quarter, T 24 North, 3 Range 9 West. 4 I stand corrected. The name of that pool would 5 Q. now be the Bisti-Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool? 6 7 Α. Right. Okay. Mr. Hayden, has Ms. Florene Davidson who 8 Q. prepares the nomenclature order for signature by the 9 Director, has she been advised of this change? 10 11 Yes, I e-mailed her and then actually talked to 12 her on the phone to make sure we were clear on it, right after I found out about this, about a week ago. I'll make 13 sure that I bring it up again. 14 15 Okay. And is Dugan Production Company aware of Q. the change that you're proposing? 16 17 Yeah, Dugan Production Company is the source of Α. the misunderstanding. 18 I see, okay. 19 Q. Do you have anything to add to your testimony 20 today here, Mr. Hayden? 21 I think this pretty much covers it, unless you 22 Α. 23 need more. EXAMINER CATANACH: I think that pretty much does 24

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it.
