Arrington Oil and Gas, 5 Incorporated, for an unorthodox gas well location, Lea 6 7 County, New Mexico. Call for appearances in this case. 8 MR. FELDEWERT: Mr. Examiner, Michael Feldewert 9 10 with the Santa Fe office of Holland and Hart and Campbell 11 and Carr, appearing on behalf of the Applicant, David H. 12 Arrington Oil and Gas, Inc. EXAMINER CATANACH: Okay, any additional 13 14 appearances? Okay, there being none, Mr. Feldewert? 15 16 MR. FELDEWERT: Mr. Examiner, I have no witnesses This case was heard by Examiner Stogner on March 17 today. The Application at that time was not opposed, and 18 the 8th. 19 the testimony was taken at that hearing. Subsequently Examiner Stogner expressed some 20 concerns in a letter about the adequacy of the original 21 advertisement and therefore readvertised the case for 22 I have a copy of that letter which I will mark as 23 today. Exhibit 7, if I may approach. Arrington Exhibit Number 7 24 25 is the March 10th, 2001, letter in which Mr. Stogner

expressed his concern about the original advertisement and 1 set forth the advertisement that was used here today. 2 I think if you compare the two, what I was able 3 to tell was that there was a slight adjustment to the pool 4 name, there was a one-foot change in the location, and he 5 also noted that in this advertisement there was a deepening 6 of an existing well. 7 David Arrington Oil and Gas, Inc., now believes 8 that the case is ripe for an order, and we ask that given 9 the passage of time since when this case was presented that 10 an order be entered at the Division's earliest convenience. 11 12 EXAMINER CATANACH: Mr. Feldewert, was there any 13 kind of notice problems? 14 MR. FELDEWERT: No. Apparently, from what I understand, it was just a change in the advertisement, and 15 I guess they had made a slight adjustment to the pool name 16 that was originally advertised and noted a one-foot change 17 in the location. 18 EXAMINER CATANACH: Okay, anything further? 19 20 MR. FELDEWERT: No. 21 EXAMINER CATANACH: There being nothing further, 22 Case 12,608 will be taken under advisement. While entering data into the Division's automation system concerning my hearing on March 8, 2001, I discovered the advertisement in this case contained an insufficient legal description of the well, dedicated acreage, and proposed provocative intervals. I have therefore prepared the following which will placed on the April 5, 2001 hearing docket:

"CASE 12608: (REOPENED AND READVERTISED)

Application of David H. Arrington Oil & Gas, Inc. for an unorthodox gas well location, Lea County, New Mexico. Applicant seeks approval to deepen its existing Mayfly "14" State Well No. 4 (API No. 30-025-34865), located at an unorthodox gas well location 1650 feet from the North line and 371 feet from the West line (Unit E) of Section 14, Township 16 South, Range 35 East, NMPM Lea County, New Mexico, from its current depth of 11,550 feet to an approximate depth of 12,100 feet in order to test both the Townsend-Morrow Gas Pool and deeper Undesignated Townsend-Mississippian Gas Pool within a standard 320-acre stand-up gas spacing and proration unit comprising the W/2 of section 14. This well is located approximately five miles west of Lovington, New Mexico".
