STATEMENT OF CASE

APPLICANT

Application of EOG Resources, Inc. for compulsory pooling, Lea County, New Mexico. Applicant in the above-styled cause seeks an order pooling all mineral interests from the surface through the top 100 feet of the Mississippian Chester formation underlying the W/2 of Section 7, Township 24 South, Range 34 East, N.M.P.M. for any formations and/or pools developed on 320-acre spacing which includes but is not necessarily limited to the South Bell Lake-Morrow Gas Pool. Applicant proposes to dedicate these pooled units to its Bell Lake Unit Well No. 8 to be drilled at a standard location 1980 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the East line (Unit E) of said Section 7.
