This particular case was heard and taken under advisement at the April 11th hearing. It was also heard in conjunction with two other cases of similar circumstances. However, during the preparation of an order in that case an error was discovered in the advertisement and the notice, and this matter was then reopened to address those issues.

MR. CARR: May it please the Examiner, my name is William F. Carr with the law firm Holland and Hart, L.L.P. We represent Raptor Resources, Inc., in this matter.

EXAMINER STOGNER: Any other appearances?
Mr. Carr?

MR. CARR: May it please the Examiner, following your call we prepared and filed an Amended Application correcting the description of location of one of the wells involved in this case. We renotified all affected parties pursuant to the rules of the Division and the stipulated declaratory judgment that's in place concerning

applications involving infill drilling in the Jalmat Pool. 1 The notice period has run, and I have an affidavit to 2 submit in this case confirming that the proper notice has 3 now been given and that the well locations have been 4 5 corrected. EXAMINER STOGNER: Now, in particular one of the 6 7 problems was --MR. CARR: Yes. 8 EXAMINER STOGNER: -- the unorthodox well 9 location of that. 10 MR. CARR: Correct. 11 EXAMINER STOGNER: Those people were again 12 notified; is that correct? 13 MR. CARR: Yes, they were. And the notice letter 14 provides not only the correct location but states what the 15 erroneous prior location was, so that the notice letter not 16 only -- It doesn't just say here's an application, it tells 17 them what was wrong with the original one. 18 EXAMINER STOGNER: Do you have that? 19 MR. CARR: Yes, sir, I do. 20 EXAMINER STOGNER: Do you know if your client 21 received my correspondence in this matter? 22 23 MR. CARR: I contacted them yesterday morning, and they had received no comments from any of the affected 24 25 parties, no contact.
