WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at 1 2 9:13 a.m.: EXAMINER STOGNER: I'm going to call at this time 3 Case Number 12,653, which is the Application of Chesapeake 4 5 Operating, Inc., for an unorthodox oil well location, Lea 6 County, New Mexico. Call for appearances. 7 8 MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, Jim Bruce of Santa Fe, 9 representing the Applicant. I just have a few statements. 10 MR. CARR: May it please the Examiner, my name is William F. Carr with the Santa Fe law firm Holland and 11 Hart. We earlier entered an appearance in this matter for 12 Conoco, Inc. We have discovered that the interest has been 13 14 assigned to Texland Petroleum, and therefore we are withdrawing from the case and have no objection to the 15 16 Application of Chesapeake Operating. 17 EXAMINER STOGNER: Thank you, Mr. Carr. 18 Mr. Bruce? 19 MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, I've handed you a land 20 plat from the case. If you'll look at that, originally this case was filed in Case Number 12,595. If you'll look 21 22 at that land plat, originally there was a south-half northeast-quarter unit for this well. The well location 23 itself has remained the same. 24 25 A hearing was held in Case 12,595 on February 22,

Land and geophysical testimony was presented at that 1 2001. 2 matter for the necessity of the unorthodox location. After that, due to reasons connected with 3 Chesapeake's farmout on the acreage, they were required to 4 5 reorient the unit to a standup unit. 6 There was a hearing held on May 31 [sic] in this case at which land testimony was presented, but due to 7 8 Conoco's objection, the matter was continued until now. As Mr. Carr --9 10 EXAMINER STOGNER: Okay, I'm sorry, back up. MR. BRUCE: Yes. 11 EXAMINER STOGNER: When was it heard? 12 MR. BRUCE: May 3rd. 13 14 EXAMINER STOGNER: May 3rd, okay. That was 15 before David Catanach. Okay --16 MR. BRUCE: Yes. 17 EXAMINER STOGNER: -- please continue. 18 MR. BRUCE: Conoco objected it was being 19 continued to this date to have geologic testimony 20 presented. Conoco subsequently discovered that although 21 the public records show that Conoco owned an interest, 22 there is an unrecorded operating agreement under which Texland Petroleum, Inc., actually owns the deep rights, the 23 24 Strawn rights, in the east half of the northeast quarter of 25 Section 5.

What I've handed you marked as Exhibit A is a waiver of objection to the location signed by Texland Petroleum, Inc. I was out of town this week. I meant to get an affidavit from the landman testifying to the fact that Texland is the owner of the operating rights in the east half of the northeast quarter. We can handle this one of two ways. Either we can get an affidavit, or I believe that the landman will be here on May 31st for a hearing, and we can have her testify to that fact, just so that there's something in the record showing that Texland is indeed the offset operator. EXAMINER STOGNER: Okay now, on May 3rd was there land witnesses here then? MR. BRUCE: There was -- Chesapeake had their landman here. But at that time everyone still believed that Conoco owned the interest. About a week later it was discovered that Conoco owned no interest in the offset, that under an unrecorded operating agreement Texland actually owns this interest. EXAMINER STOGNER: Okay, so you're representing Conoco, Mr. Carr? MR. CARR: Yes, I am.

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25 EXAMINER STOGNER: Okay, I think an affidavit
