Dear Ms. Wrotenbery:

I am the owner of an Overriding Royalty Interest (ORRI), which will be affected by the proposed well described in the application referenced above.

I object to the unorthodox well location Nearburg Exploration Company, L.L.C. is proposing for its Poco Mesa "26" State Com Well No. 1 as requested of you from Mr. Michael H. Feldewert, Attorney at Law, until such time as my ORRI as shown on Exhibit "C" is corrected.

I strongly object to Exhibit "C" attached to the approval request. My objection is to my ORRI being limited to production from ONLY the depth of 5000 feet to 6,673 feet. (See attached Exhibit "C", which is part of Mr. Feldewert's letter.)

I acquired my interest to this property from the U. S. Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management on July 15,1974. (See attached BLM document.)

This lease was later assigned to Gulf Oil Company and subsequently Chevron USA. (See letter of offer and our acceptance of terms contained in the attached letter dated July 15, 1974, from Gulf Oil Company.) These documents indicate my brother, Edward Hooper, and I retaining an ORRI totaling five percent (5%).

As you can clearly see, our ORRI is not limited to any specific depth or any other limitations, and thus our objection to Feldewert's Exhibit "C", which is incorrect.

If "Nearburg" obtains production from this proposed well, we will expect to be paid an ORRI from any and all production.

For this reason, Feldewert's Exhibit "C", as written and submitted is UNACCEPTABLE as well as the proposed plan to cut royalty owners out of any production to which they are legally and rightfully entitled to under this proposed well,

My overriding royalty is now 1.25%, as my former spouse (Shirley Hooper-Garcia, 2651 Camino Chueco, Santa Fe, NM 87501) has the remaining 1.25%.
