## STATEMENT OF CASE

### APPLICANT

Applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interests in the W/2 of Section 31, Township 16 South, Range 36 East for all formations and/or pools developed on 320-acre spacing which presently includes but is not necessarily limited to the Undesignated East Shoe Bar-Chester Gas Pool. Said unit is to be dedicated to Applicant's proposed Double Hackle "31" State Com. Well No. 1 to be located at an unorthodox location 2400 feet from the South line and 1340 feet from the West line (Unit K) of said section at a depth sufficient to test all formations from the surface to the base of the Mississippian formation. Also to be considered will the cost of drilling and completing said well and the allocation of the cost thereof, actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well, and a charge for risk involved in drilling said well. Said area is located approximately 4 miles southwest of Lovington, New Mexico.


