APPLICATION OF RAPTOR RESOURCES, INC. FOR TWO UNORTHODOX INFILL GAS WELL LOCATIONS AND SIMULTANEOUS DEDICATION, LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

APPLICATION

RAPTOR RESOURCES, INC. ("Raptor"), through its undersigned attorneys, (i) seeks an exception to the well location requirements of the "Special Pool Rules and Regulations for the Jalmat Gas Pool," as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended for two unorthodox infill Jalmat gas well locations, and (ii) pursuant to the Stipulated Declaratory Judgment issued by the First Judicial District Court in Santa Fe County, New Mexico on December 15, 2000, makes application for an order approving the simultaneous dedication of all Jalmat Gas Pool production to an existing 440.50-acre non-standard gas spacing and proration unit (authorized by Division Order NSP-1636-A (L) (SD), dated July 18, 2000) comprising Lots 3 and 4, S/2 NW/4, SW/4, W/2 SE/4 and the SE/4 SE/4 of Section 5, Township 22 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, and in support of its application Raptor states:

1. Raptor is the operator of the non-standard gas spacing and proration unit in the Jalmat Gas Pool comprised of Lots 3 and 4, S/2 NW/4, SW/4, W/2

SE/4 and the SE/4 SE/4 of Section 5, Township 22 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, to which are currently dedicated the following wells:

- (A) State "A" A/C-2 Well No. 2 (API No. 30-025-08791), located at an unorthodox gas well location 1980 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the West Line (Unit L) of Section 5;
- (B) State "A" A/C-2 Well No. 27 (API No. 30-025-08789), located at an unorthodox gas well location 660 feet from the South and East lines (Unit P) of Section 5;
- (C) State "A" A/C-2 Well No. 33 (API No. 30-025-08793), located at an unorthodox gas well location 660 feet from the South line and 1980 feet from the East line (Unit O) of Section 5;
- (D) State "A" A/C-2 Well No. 34 (API No. 30-025-08794), located at an unorthodox gas well location 1980 feet from the South and East lines (Unit J) of Section 5;
- (E) State "A" A/C-2 Well No. 44 (API No. 30-025-08797), located at an unorthodox gas well location 1980 feet from the North and West lines (Unit F) of Section 5;
- (F) State "A" A/C-2 Well No. 46 (API No. 30-025-08800), located at an unorthodox gas well location 660 feet from South

line and 1980 feet from the West line (Unit N) of Section 5; and

- (G) State "A" A/C-2 Well No. 47 (API No. 30-025-08798), located at an unorthodox gas well location 660 feet from the North line and 1980 feet from the West Line (Unit C) of Section 5.
- 2. Raptor proposes to add two Jalmat gas wells to this spacing and proration unit:
 - (A) The State "A" A/C-2 Well No. 78 (API No. 30-025-34910) located an unorthodox gas well location 1980 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the West line (Unit E) of Section 5 which Raptor plans to re-enter and re-complete from the Seven Rivers formation, South Eunice (Seven Rivers-Queen) Pool, to the Jalmat Gas Pool; and
 - (B) The State "A" A/C-2 Well No. 81 which Raptor proposes to drill at an unorthodox gas well location 2080 feet from the South line and 1980 feet from the West line (Unit K) of Section 5.

3. The proposed locations for the State "A" A/C-2 Well Nos. 78 and 81

are unorthodox for the "Special Rules and Regulations for the Jalmat Gas Pool,"

promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, provide for wells

located on 440.50-acre spacing units to be located no closer than 990 feet from

the outer boundary of the unit.

4. Raptor seeks to simultaneously dedicated the Jalmat production from

each of its proposed new infill gas wells and the existing Jalmat gas wells to this

non-standard 440.50 Jalmat Gas spacing and proration unit.

5. Raptor's proposed infill wells are necessary to efficiently and

economically drain the subject 440.50-acre spacing and proration unit.

6. Attached hereto as Exhibit A is a list of the names and addresses of

the persons to whom notice of this application has been sent.

7. Approval of this application will be in the best interests of

conservation, the prevention of waste and the protection of correlative rights.

Application

WHEREFORE, Raptor Resources, Inc. requests that this application be set for hearing before an examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on June 14, 2001, and that, after as required by law and hearing as required by the rules of the Division, this application be granted.

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Application of Raptor Resources, Inc. for two unorthodox infill gas well locations and simultaneous dedication, Lea County, New Mexico. Applicant seeks an exception to the well location requirements provided within the "Special Pool Rules and Regulations for the Jalmat Gas Pool," as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, for the following two unorthodox gas well locations within an existing standard 440.50-acre spacing and proration unit comprised of Lots 3 and 4, S/2 NW/4, SW/4, W/2 SE/4 and the SE/4 SE/4 of Section 5, Township 22 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico:

- (A) The State "A" A/C-2 Well No. 78 (API No. 30-025-34910) to be re-entered and re-completed at an unorthodox infill gas well location 1980 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the West line (Unit E) of Section 5, and
- (B) The State "A" A/C-2 Well No. 81 to be drilled at an unorthodox infill gas well location 2080 feet from the south line and 1980 feet from the West line (Unit K) of Section 5.

This unit is currently dedicated to Raptor Resources, Inc.'s:

- (A) State "A" A/C-2 Well No. 2 (API No. 30-025-08791), located at an unorthodox gas well location 1980 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the West Line (Unit L) of Section 5,
- (B) State "A" A/C-2 Well No. 27 (API No. 30-025-08789), located at an unorthodox gas well location 660 feet from the South and East lines (Unit P) of Section 5,
- (C) State "A" A/C-2 Well No. 33 (API No. 30-025-08793), located at an unorthodox gas well location 660 feet from the South line and 1980 feet from the East line (Unit O) of Section 5,

- (D) State "A" A/C-2 Well No. 34 (API No. 30-025-08794), located at an unorthodox gas well location 1980 feet from the South and East lines (Unit J) of Section 5,
- (E) State "A" A/C-2 Well No. 44 (API No. 30-025-08797), located at an unorthodox gas well location 1980 feet from the North and West lines (Unit F) of Section 5,
- (F) State "A" A/C-2 Well No. 46 (API No. 30-025-08800), located at an unorthodox gas well location 660 feet from South line and 1980 feet from the West line (Unit N) of Section 5, and
- (G) State "A" A/C-2 Well No. 47 (API No. 30-025-08798), located at an unorthodox gas well location 660 feet from the North line and 1980 feet from the West Line (Unit C) of Section 5.

Further, the applicant, pursuant to the rules governing the Jalmat Gas Pool and the Stipulated Declaratory Judgment issued by the First Judicial District Court in Santa Fe County, New Mexico on December 15, 2000, seeks to simultaneously dedicated Jalmat production to this 440.50-acre unit from all nine of the above-described State "A" A/C-2 Well Nos. 2, 27, 33, 34, 44, 46, 47, 78 and 81.

This spacing unit is located approximately 5.5 miles southwest of Eunice, New Mexico.

Ladies and Gentlemen:

This letter is to advise you that Raptor Resources, Inc. has filed the enclosed application with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division seeking an exception to the well location requirements provided by the "Special Rules and Regulations for the Jalmat Gas Pool," as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, for its proposed State "A" A/C-2 Well No. 78 to be re-entered and recompleted in the Jalmat Gas Pool at an unorthodox infill gas well location 1980 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the West line (Unit E) and its proposed State "A" A/C-2 Well No. 81 to be drilled and completed in the Jalmat Gas Pool at an unorthodox infill gas well location 2080 feet from the South line and 1980 feet from the West line (Unit K) of Section 5, Township 22 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

Raptor Resources, Inc., pursuant to the "Special Rules and Regulations for the Jalmat Gas Pool" and the Stipulated Declaratory Judgment issued by the First Judicial District Court in Santa Fe County, New Mexico, on December 15, 2000, in Cause No. D-0101-CV9902927, seeks authority to simultaneously dedicate the Jalmat production from these proposed new infill wells and the existing Jalmat gas wells identified in the enclosed application to a previously approved non-

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standard 440.5-acre non-standard gas spacing and proration unit in the Jalmat Gas Pool comprised of Lots 3 and 4, S/2 NW/4, SW/4, W/2 SE/4 and SE/4 SE/4 of Section 5, Township 22 South, Range 36 East, NMPM.

This application has been set for hearing before a Division Examiner on June 14, 2001. You are not required to attend this hearing, but as an owner of an interest that may be affected by this application, you may appear and present testimony. Failure to appear at that time and become a party of record will preclude you from challenging the matter at a later date.

Parties appearing in cases are required by Division Rule 1208.B to file a Prehearing Statement three days in advance of a scheduled hearing. This statement must include: the names of the parties and their attorneys; a concise statement of the case; the names of all witnesses the party

will call to testify at the hearing; the approximate time the party will need to present its case; and identification of any procedural matters that are to be resolved prior to the hearing.
