19	to be drilled at a standard location to test the Mesaverde
20	formation in the northwest quarter of Section 5.
21	I have provided for you a plat of the proposed
22	spacing unit in yellow, as well as Order That was
23	McElvain Exhibit Number 1.
24	McElvain Exhibit Number 2 is Division Order
25	Number R-8615, which was entered back in March of 1988,

1	which was a pooling order that approved this nonstandard
2	unit for a well that was drilled to the Mancos formation
3	underlying this acreage.
4	I then have included as McElvain Exhibit Number 3
5	an affidavit giving notice to all of the parties that were
6	excluded from the proration unit in this section. This was
7	a matter that would have been handled administratively
8	except for the fact that the nonstandard unit crosses
9	section lines.
10	The only point that I would make, Mr. Examiner
11	and I'll offer testimony if need be there are two I
12	noticed as I was flipping through this notice affidavit,
13	there were two parties that did not return the certified
14	letter. One was Gavilan Dome Properties and one was Mesa
15	Grande Resources, Inc. I think you will see from prior
16	submissions by McElvain to the Division in pooling cases
17	that these addresses have been used for these two interest
18	owners before and that it has been a good address. It
19	seems to be a situation where sometimes they pick up their
20	mail and sometimes they don't.
21	And that's all I have at this point, unless you
22	feel that testimony is necessary.
