Dear Ms. Wrotenbery:

Leonard Resource Investment Corporation ("Leonard Resource") requests that the well commencement deadline be extended for 60 days. The reason for this request is as follows:

- 1. The above order grants Leonard Resource until January 31, 2002 to commence the well.
- 2. At the time of hearing, Leonard Resource thought that all parties were either pooled or had voluntarily agreed to join in the well. However, a title defect arose after the hearing (regarding an interest Leonard Resource thought it had leased), and the dispute will not be finally resolved until the end of this month.

As a result of the foregoing, Leonard Resource has lost approximately two months of the allotted commencement period, and requests that the commencement deadline be extended to March 31, 2002.
