WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at 1 2 8:27 a.m.: EXAMINER STOGNER: Okay, at this time I'm going 3 to call Case Number 12,736, which is the Application of 4 KUKUI Operating Company for an unorthodox gas well 5 location, Eddy County, New Mexico. 6 I'll call for appearances. 7 MR. CARR: May it please the Examiner, my name is 8 William F. Carr with the Santa Fe office of Holland and 9 Hart, L.L.P. We represent KUKUI Operating Company in this 10 matter, and I have a brief statement. 11 12 EXAMINER STOGNER: Any other appearances? 13 Please continue, Mr. Carr. 14 MR. CARR: Mr. Stogner, the Application of KUKUI 15 was filed in August of this year seeking an unorthodox location for its Goodnight "35" Federal Well Number 3. 16 The location was required because of its proximity to the 17 18 potash mines in Eddy County. 19 An objection to that Application was filed by 20 Devon and later joined in by Kaiser-Francis. Following -and because of those objections, the matter was set for 21 22 hearing. 23 Following notice that the matter was going to 24 hearing, KUKUI, Devon and Kaiser-Francis, through Mr. Kellahin and I, were able to reach a voluntary agreement by 25

which they withdrew their objection to the location in 1 exchange for a 33-percent production penalty on the well. 2 We've provided copies of that agreement to the 3 Division and requested that the unorthodox location be 4 approved administratively. And that has been done, and so 5 we request that the Application of KUKUI Operating Company 6 in Case 12,736 be dismissed. 7 EXAMINER STOGNER: Anything further in Case 8 12,736? 9 Then this case will be dismissed at this time. 10 Please note also that that administrative order 11 12 in this matter was NSL-4658, which was issued November the 13 2nd of 2001, and that order was also cc'd to Mr. Kellahin who, as I understand, is legal counsel for Devon and 14 15 Kaiser-Francis.
