WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at 11:45 a.m.:

EXAMINER BROOKS: At this time we'll call Case Number 12,760, Application of Mewbourne Oil Company for compulsory pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico.

MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, Jim Bruce of Santa Fe, representing the Applicant.

I have no witnesses, I just have a short statement.

EXAMINER BROOKS: Any other appearances? Very good, you may proceed.

MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, a couple weeks ago I made a short statement in this case, but I had -- during my move I had misplaced my exhibits. Just briefly, Mewbourne has drilled a well in the east half of Section 18, 19 South, 28 East, and all operating rights, working interest owners, have joined in that well or were pooled into the well.

record title owners in one state lease comprising 40 acres were deceased. Their heirs could basically not be located except for one, and the State Land Office will not allow the well to be produced until the Com agreement was signed by all record title owners or they were force pooled. The two record title owners of the lease covering the north --

I believe it was the northwest quarter of the southeast quarter, are Elmo Jones and Gerald Jones, both of whom are deceased.

We tracked down the heirs of one of them. The rest of them are all to the four winds, and we could not locate all of these people, so it was impossible to get a communitization agreement signed by everyone as required by the State Land Office. Therefore, we force pooled these record title owners under the Division rule allowing it to be done without witnesses.

I've submitted to you Exhibit 1 which is my affidavit of notice. One grandson of one of the record title owners was located in Lubbock, and I sent notice of this hearing to him. I have received no objection.

Exhibit Number 2 is an affidavit of publication from the Carlsbad newspaper. We notified the two record title owners and all of their various spouses, heirs, et cetera, by publication in that newspaper.

Again, these people own no operating rights, they just own bare record title.

And we would move the admission of Exhibits 1 and 2 and ask that an order be issued force pooling these people so that the State Land Office will approve the communitization agreement and so that the well can be produced.

EXAMINER BROOKS: Very good, Exhibits 1 and 2 are 1 2 admitted. 3 Apparently we've lost the file on this case. 4 Could you provide us with a copy of the Application? 5 MR. BRUCE: Yes, I will do that. 6 EXAMINER BROOKS: Okay, that would be helpful. 7 Hopefully the file will surface, but just in case, I would 8 assume the Application and the -- Well, you've given us a copy of the notice affidavit here, which includes the 9 10 notice, so the only thing it will be necessary to 11 reconstruct will be the Application itself. 12 MR.
