## **APPLICATION**

DAVID H. ARRINGTON OIL & GAS, INC. ("Arrington"), through its undersigned attorneys, hereby makes application to amend Order No. R-11667 (entered in Case No. 12675) to provide for the drilling of a gas well at an unorthodox location in the NW/4 SW/4 (Unit L) of Section 31, Township 16 South, Range 36 East. In support of this application, Arrington states:

- 1. On October 10, 2001, the Division entered Order No. R-11667 pooling all uncommitted mineral interests from the surface to the base of the Mississippian formation underlying Lots 1-4 and the E/2 W/2 (W/2 equivalent) of Section 31, Township 16 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico to form a 308.84-acre stand-up gas spacing and proration unit for any and all formations and pools developed on 320-acre spacing within that vertical extent, which presently includes the Undesignated East Shoe Bar-Chester Gas Pool.
- 2. Order No. R-11667 denied Arrington's request for approval of an unorthodox gas well location on the grounds that Arrington failed to demonstrate an unorthodox location was geologically superior to a standard location. Since the entry of Order R-11667, Arrington has reviewed the relevant data and now has evidence demonstrating an unorthodox location in the NW/4 SW/4 (Unit L) of Section 31 is superior to a standard location within the spacing and proration unit established by Order R-11667.

3. Arrington therefore seeks approval to dedicate the spacing and proration unit

established by Order R-11667 to its proposed Double Hackle "31" State Com. Well No. 1 to be

drilled at an unorthodox location in the NW/4 SW/4 (Unit L) of Section 31 to a depth sufficient to

test any and all formations from the surface to the base of the Mississippian formation.

4. The Division has extended the time for Arrington to commence drilling a well under

Order No. R-11667 and that order remains in full force and effect.

5. Approval of this application will be in the best interest of conservation, the prevention

of waste and the protection of correlative rights.

6. A list of the names and addresses of the persons to whom notice has been sent is

attached hereto as Exhibit A.

WHEREFORE, David H. Arrington Oil & Gas, Inc. requests that this application be set

for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on January 24, 2002, and that

after notice and hearing as required by law the Division amend Order No. R-11667 and approve

the proposed unorthodox well location.
