

This letter is to advise you that Sun Valley Energy Corporation has filed the enclosed application with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division seeking the force pooling of all mineral interests from the surface through the San Andres formation in a standard oil spacing and proration unit comprised of the SW/4 NW/4 of Section 12 Township 18 South, Range 38 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico. SunValley proposes to dedicate the referenced pooled unit to its Monk Well No. 1 to be drilled at a standard location 1980 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the West line of said Section 12.
