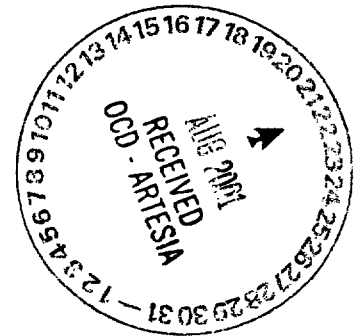

I am trying to locate information to which the CIBP was set so I may recomplete the Cannon Et Al 001Y. The Marlisue Queen unit's wells just needs to be turned on and find out whether the person that bought them is going to send in the C104's that I mailed to him to finish and file.

Tim, be assured that this is going to be taken care of just as soon as I can figure out why these individuals are not filing the proper paperwork. Also I have not been just stalling this work, I have been plugging wells in other districts.
