So we would ask that you take into consideration the transcript and the exhibits introduced in Case 12,598, which is the prior hearing.

To support that, Richardson has executed an affidavit, which is Exhibit Number 2, indicating the cost provisions haven't changed, the parties to be pooled are the same parties as originally pooled, and they're requesting that the overhead rates adopted in the prior pooling order be reissued, and they represent there were no other change of circumstances with regards to this case.

EXAMINER BROOKS: Sounds like an easy one.

MR. KELLAHIN: Exhibit Number 1 is a certificate of notification of hearing in which we served the same parties that were originally pooled, a Mr. William Hall and a Sherman and Helen Singleton. None of those parties have contacted me, and there have been no appearances in opposition to reinstating the pooling order.
