STATEMENT OF CASE

APPLICANT

Applicant seeks an exception to the applicable gas well location set-back requirements governing all formations or pools from the surface to the base of the Granite Wash or top of the basement formation for its Pay "AYY" Federal Com. Well No. 1 to be drilled 6660 feet from the North line and 330 feet from the West line (Unit D) of Section 11, Township 8 South, Range 26 East, to be dedicated to the following described spacing units: (i) the W/2 of Section 11 to form a standard 320-acre stand-up gas spacing unit for all formations or pools developed on 320-acre spacing, which presently includes but is not necessarily limited to the North Foor Ranch-Pre Permian Gas Pool; and (ii) the NW/4 to form a standard 160-acre spacing and proration unit for all formations or pools
