APPLICANT

Applicant in the above-styled cause seeks an order pooling all mineral interests in all formations from the base of the Dakota formation to the base of the Pennsylvanian formations in Section 15, Township 31 North, Range 11 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico as follows: all of Section 15 for all formations and/or pools developed on 640-acre spacing; the W/2 for all formations and/or pools developed on 320-acre spacing; and the SW/4 for all formations and/or pools developed on 160-acre spacing. These pooled units are to be dedicated to the Bandy Well No. 1 which will be drilled as a wildcat well at a standard

location 1750 feet from the South line and 1685 feet from the West line of said Section 15. Said area is located approximately 4 miles North of Aztec, New Mexico.


