3	EXAMINER JONES: Call for appearances in Case		
4	12,858, Application of David H. Arrington Oil and Gas,		
5	Incorporated, for compulsory pooling, Lea County, New		
6	Mexico.		
7	MR. FELDEWERT: Mr. Examiner, Michael Feldewert		
8	with the Santa Fe office of Holland and Hart, appearing on		
9	behalf of the Applicant, David H. Arrington Oil and Gas,		
10	Inc.		
11	EXAMINER JONES: Any other appearances? Guess		
12	not.		
13	Go ahead.		
14	MR. FELDEWERT: Mr. Examiner, this case was		
15	originally presented on November 1st, 2001, to Examiner		
16	Brooks under Case Number 12,752.		
17	On November 16th, 2001, the Division entered		
18	Order Number R-11,690, which pooled the interests of the		
19	respective owners to form spacing units for Arrington's		
20	proposed Royal Stimulator 31 Well Number 2. And if I may		
21	approach, I've got a copy of the order I just referenced.		
22	Mr. Examiner, this pooling order expired by its		
23	own terms on February 28th, 2002. Arrington now intends to		
24	proceed with this directional drilling project. They ask		
25	that a new pooling order be entered by the Division.		

STEVEN T. BRENNER, CCR (505) 989-9317 Notice of this hearing was sent to all interest
owners in the property, and I have provided to you a copy
of our notice affidavit, which I've marked as Exhibit
Number 1 in this matter.

5 And I want to bring your attention to the fact that the return receipts for this notice indicate that 6 7 certain interest owners did not return their receipts. These are unleased mineral owners who own less than one 8 percent in the west half of Section 31. They are James E. 9 10 Bailey and Wilma J. Lair, the Estate of Thelma Ann Turner, 11 Robert Freck, F-r-e-c-k, and Shawn Freck, F-r-e-c-k. And 12 you'll see on the notice affidavit that we have blanks next to the return receipts. Those are the four individuals 13 14 that Arrington was unable to locate.

15 The transcript of the hearing in Case Number 16 12,752 contains testimony from Arrington's landman 17 identifying the efforts that were undertaken to locate 18 these four individuals.

19 So we would ask as part of this case that the 20 transcript and exhibits from the hearing in Case Number 21 12,752 be incorporated into this matter.

22 EXAMINER JONES: Okay, it is so incorporated. 23 MR. FELDEWERT: And this matter, as you know, was 24 advertised in the absence of objection that it would be 25 taken under advisement, so we ask that Exhibit Number 1 be

FELDEWERT: Correct, they received an order, it expired by its own terms in February of this year. 10 11 Arrington now would like to proceed with this project, so 12 we ask that a new pooling order be entered by the Division. 13 EXAMINER JONES: Okay, we will incorporate the 14 previous testimony in the record and take this case under advisement. 15 16 MR.
