## APPLICATION

DAVID H. ARRINGTON OIL & GAS, INC. ("Arrington"), through its undersigned attorneys, hereby makes application pursuant to the provisions of N.M.S.A. 1978, Section 30-2-17, for an order pooling all mineral interests for all formations and/or pools developed on 320-acre spacing from the surface to the base of the Mississippian formation, under the following acreage in Section 34, Township 14 South, Range 35 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, in the following manner:

The W/2 of said section 34 to form a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for all formations and/or pools developed on 320-acre spacing within that vertical extent.

Said spacing and proration units are to be dedicated to Arrington's proposed Chocolate Foam Wing No. 1 Well, to be drilled at standard location in the NW/4 SW/4 of said Section 34, and in support of its application states:

- 1. Arrington is a working interest owner in said Section 34 and has the right to drill thereon.
- 2. Arrington proposes to dedicate the above-referenced spacing or proration units to a well to be drilled at a standard location in the SW/4 of said Section 34, to a depth sufficient to test any and all formations to the base of the Mississippian formation.

3. Arrington has sought and been unable to obtain voluntary agreement for the

development of these spacing and proration units from those interest owners identified on Exhibit

A to this application.

4. Said pooling of interests will avoid the drilling of unnecessary wells, will prevent

waste and will protect correlative rights.

5. In order to permit the Applicant to obtain its just and fair share of the oil and gas

underlying the subject lands, all mineral interests should be pooled, and David H. Arrington Oil

& Gas, Inc. should be designated the operator of the well to be drilled.

WHEREFORE, David H. Arrington Oil & Gas, Inc. requests that this application be set

for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on May 16, 2002, and, after

notice and hearing as required by law, the Division enter its order pooling the lands, including

provisions designating Arrington operator of these spacing and proration units, and authorizing

Arrington to recover its costs of drilling, equipping and completing the well, its costs of

supervision while drilling and after completion, including overhead charges, imposing a risk factor

for the risk assumed by Arrington in drilling, completing and equipping the well.
