WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at 1 2 10:22 a.m.: EXAMINER BROOKS: Okay, at this time we will call 3 Case Number 12,879, Application of Chi Energy Corporation 4 for compulsory pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico; Case 5 Number 12,880, Application of Chi Energy Corporation for 6 compulsory pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico; and Case 7 Number 12,881, Application of Chi Energy Corporation for 8 compulsory pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico. 9 Call for appearances. 10 MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, Jim Bruce of Santa Fe 11 representing the Applicant. I have one witness. 12 EXAMINER BROOKS: Okay, you may call your 13 witness. 14 He needs to be sworn. I had the others sworn 15 twice, so I'll just have him sworn once. 16 (Thereupon, the witness was sworn.) 17 ROBERT H. BELL, 18 the witness herein, after having been first duly sworn upon 19 his oath, was examined and testified as follows: 20 DIRECT EXAMINATION 21 BY MR. BRUCE: 22 23 Q. Would you please state your name for the record? Robert H. Bell. 24 Α. 25 Q. Where do you reside?

6 Roswell, New Mexico. 1 Α. 2 Q. What is your occupation? Α. I am an independent petroleum landman. 3 And what is your relationship to Chi Energy in Q. 4 this matter? 5 A. I've been retained by Chi Energy to help 6 facilitate these com agreements and a compulsory pooling. 7 Okay. Have you previously testified before the 8 Q. Division? 9 Yes, I have. Α. 10 And were your credentials as an expert petroleum Q. 11 landman accepted as a matter of record? 12 Yes, they were. 13 Α. And are you familiar with the land matters 14 Q. involved in these three particular Applications? 15 16 Α. Yes, sir, I am. MR. BRUCE: Okay. Mr. Examiner, I would tender 17 18 Mr. Bell as an expert petroleum landman. EXAMINER BROOKS: So qualified. 19 (By Mr. Bruce) Mr. Bell, let's start off by 20 Q. going through these cases. In the first one, 12,878, what 21 22 does Chi Energy seek in this case?

STEVEN T. BRENNER, CCR (505) 989-9317

Chi seeks to pool the west half of Section 4,

Township 17 South, Range 28 East, from the surface to the

base of the Morrow formation for all formations spaced on

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1 | 160 and 320 acres.

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- Q. Okay. Now, the next two cases, 12,880, you are similarly seeking to pool the north half of adjoining Section 10?
 - A. That's correct.
- Q. And in the Case 12,881, you are seeking to pool the south half of Section 10, correct?
 - A. That's correct.
 - Q. And they're all in the same township and range?
- 10 A. Correct.
- Q. Okay, let's look first at the first case. What is Exhibit 1?
- A. Exhibit 1 is a C-102 form outlining the well unit, which is outlined in yellow, representing the west half of Section 4.
- Q. Okay, and there are two wells in this particular well unit, are there not?
- 18 A. That's correct, the Heavy Harry Number 1 and 2.
- 19 Q. Now, these are both Morrow producers?
- 20 A. That's correct.
- Q. And you would seek to pool 320 acres, as well as each quarter section, for each particular well?
- 23 A. Yes, sir.
- Q. Okay. Now, in all three poolings are you seeking to pool only overriding royalty owners?

- A. That's correct, only overrides.
- Q. Are there numerous overrides?
- A. Yes, sir, there are.

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- Q. Is this -- 17 South, 28, this is a pretty -- actually a quite old producing area, is there not?
 - A. That's correct. In some cases the wells have been producing from the 1930s and 1940s.
 - Q. Okay. As a result, the overriding royalty ownership has become quite split up?
- 10 A. Yes, it has.
- Q. And it's difficult not only just signing up
 everybody but locating everybody; would that be a correct
 statement?
- 14 A. Yes, sir.
- Q. Now, in today's hearings we are seeking to pool some owners that you have not been able to locate; is that correct?
- 18 A. That's correct.
- Q. And other owners who simply have just failed to sign -- or ratify the communitization agreement?
- 21 A. Correct.
- Q. Okay. Let's look at, again in Case 12,879, your Exhibit 2. What is that?
- A. Exhibit 2 is a copy of the communitization
 25 agreement for each of the wells. And if you'll turn to

Exhibit A, on each of the wells -- or each of the com
agreements, it will show the number of tracts involved.

For the west half of Section 4 there are four tracts, six
different ownerships. For the Hiawatha, which is the north
half --

- Q. Now, wait, let's just start on this one --
- A. Okay.

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- Q. -- let's just stick with this one. So for the first one, Exhibit 2 of Case 12,879, Exhibit A shows that there are what, five individual lease tracts, are there not?
- 12 A. Correct.
- Q. And then the next page, Exhibit B, lists the interest ownership in each of those tracts?
- 15 A. That's correct.
- Q. And all of the working interest owners have signed the com agreements, have they not?
- 18 | A. Yes.
- Q. And so what you are looking at is certain
 overriding royalties, and all of those overriding royalties
 are listed on these tracts, are they not?
 - A. That's correct.
- Q. Who do you seek to force pool in this particular case?
 - A. The overriding royalty interests that we seek to

1 force pool are marked in yellow on your exhibit. 2 want me to name those particular individuals? MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, would you require them 3 to be named for the record? 4 5 EXAMINER BROOKS: They're in the exhibit, correct? 6 7 MR. BRUCE: Yes --8 EXAMINER BROOKS: They're listed here on this --MR. BRUCE: Yes, they're all the highlighted 9 10 persons. No, it won't be necessary to 11 EXAMINER BROOKS: read the names into the record. 12 (By Mr. Bruce) Okay. And these are the only 13 Q. people you seek to force pool, the ones highlighted in 14 yellow, Mr. Bell? 15 That's correct. 16 Α. And all of the others, of whom there are many, 17 Q. the overriding royalty and working interest owners have 18 ratified or signed the communitization agreement? 19 That is correct. 20 Α. What steps did you do, did you take, to locate 21 Q. 22 these owners? 23 Α. I personally did a pretty extensive search of the state, federal, county records, sent letters to last known 24 25 addresses for most of these people, did a computer search,

Internet search, and tried to acquire old phone books and just different things, the standard steps that I would normally take.

- Q. Okay. Now, we do have several addresses. Are many of these addresses that you were able to come up with old or no longer valid addresses?
- A. That's correct. In cases where I did have an existing address I sent letters to that address, and those were all returned undeliverable.
- Q. Okay. What is Exhibit 3? And let's just stick with Case 12,879 at this point.
- A. Okay, Exhibit 3 is the correspondence that we have -- letters that I have sent out --
 - Q. Okay.

- A. -- to last known addresses for different people.
- Q. Okay. Without going through these, you did -whenever you had an address that looked reasonable, you did
 mail out a com agreement and a ratification to these
 people?
 - A. Yes, sir, I did.
- Q. Okay. In particular, let's look at this case.

 Your first letter, which is over a year ago to this Mrs.

 Mary Ann Antone, she was locatable, was she not?
 - A. Yes, she was. I talked to Mrs. Antone on the telephone in El Paso. I believe that she may be suffering

from some sort of dementia. The conversations did not go well. And I believe that the other people listed on this letter were all out of the same estate, and I -- Q. Did she claim to know them or where they were?

- A. She said that she knew of them. She said some of them were deceased; she didn't tell me which ones. And like I said, this letter is evidence I sent the letter asking for some help trying to locate these people, with no
- 9 response.
 - Q. Okay, so despite the phone calls and your letter, she never did give you any further information on the location of certain of these people?
 - A. That's correct.

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Q. Okay. And then the other letters are again from -- requests to sign the com agreement.

In your opinion, has Chi Energy made a good-faith effort to locate the names and addresses of these people and obtain their voluntary joinder?

- A. Yes, sir.
- Q. Okay. Does Chi Energy request that it be designated operator of the wells?
 - A. Yes, they do.
- Q. And since these are overrides, Chi Energy seeks
 no well costs or risk penalties; is that correct?
 - A. That's correct.

And Exhibit 4 is simply my affidavit of notice; 1 Q. 2 is that correct, Mr. Bell? Yes, sir. 3 Α. MR. BRUCE: Finally, Mr. Examiner, as to certain 4 5 of these people, we did place an advertisement in the Carlsbad newspaper, which is marked as Exhibit 5, giving 6 notice of the pooling hearing. 7 (By Mr. Bruce) Mr. Bell, let's very briefly go 8 9 through the next two cases in a more summary fashion. 10 Case 12,880, again, that's the north half of Section 10? 11 That's correct. 12 Α. 13 Q. And what is Exhibit 2 in that matter? 14 Exhibit 2 is the com agreement pertaining to the Α. Hiawatha well located in the north half of Section 10. 15 16 Okay. And so if you look at Exhibit A on that com agreement, there are what, five tracts of land again in 17 this --18 That's correct. 19 Α. 20 And are the persons you seek to force pool again highlighted in yellow? 21 Yes, they are. 22 Α. 23 And again, did you check the county records to Q. 24 attempt to locate the names and addresses of these 25 overriding royalty owners?

14 Yes, I did. 1 Α. 2 0. And is Exhibit 3 copies of the letters you sent out to the interest owners? 3 I believe so. Yes, it is. 4 Again, now, in this particular case, the Bright 5 Q. Hawk/Burkard Venture, that letter was not returned to you? 6 No, and I did make contact with the Bright Hawk/ 7 Α. Burkard Venture on several occasions. 8 They just haven't signed? 9 Q. They just haven't signed, and Chi Energy has also 10 Α. been in contact with them, trying to get them to sign. 11 With respect to the following three letters, the 12 Joan Hudson Moore, Jonel Susan Grasso and Jane Ann Hudson 13 Davis, were those letters returned to you? 14 15 Α. Yes, they were. MR. BRUCE: Okay. And again, Mr. Examiner, 16 Exhibit 4 is simply my affidavit of notice. The letter did 17 get to Bright Hawk/Burkard Venture, but was returned with 18 respect to the remaining people. 19

And Exhibit 5 is another notice published in the Carlsbad newspaper naming certain interest owners.

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- Q. (By Mr. Bruce) There were substantially fewer people in this particular well who you could not locate; is that not right, Mr. Bell?
 - A. That's correct, just the four mentioned.

Four or five? Q. 1 Right. Five, I quess. 2 A. Finally, let's move on to Case 12,881, Mr. Bell. 3 Q. 4 Again, is Exhibit 1 simply the land plat of this well? 5 Α. That's correct, the Coal Train Federal Com. 6 Q. And these wells have been drilled and completed, have they not? 7 8 Yes, all three of these wells have been drilled 9 and completed. 10 Q. Moving on to your Exhibit 2 in this case, could you identify it? 11 Exhibit 2 is the com agreement covering the Coal 12 Train Federal Com Number 1. 13 14 And Exhibit A again shows that again there are Q. five tracts in this particular well unit; is that correct? 15 16 Α. That's correct. And Exhibit B again lists the people who own 17 interest in this well, and the only ones who haven't joined 18 19 in are the ones highlighted in yellow? That's correct. 20 Α. 21 Now, on some of these you're looking at pretty small interests, are you not? Most of them? 22 23 A. Yes. Again, did you attempt to contact all of these 24 Q.

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people?

A. I did.

- Q. And your correspondence is marked Exhibit 3?
- A. That's correct.
- Q. What about Weller Energy, what was -- Have they responded to you?
- A. No, they have not. We have sent them several letters, have been unable to contact them by phone. The address that I have here, I believe, is an accurate address. None of the correspondence has been returned, however it hasn't been signed.
- Q. Okay, three of the people are the Moore, Grasso and Davis interests. In the prior well, again, that was returned, I believe?
 - A. Yes, sir.
- Q. And Bright Hawk/Burkard Venture, again, has refused to sign anything?
- 17 A. Correct.
 - MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, again, Exhibit 4 is simply my notice affidavit regarding these people. Mr. Examiner, if you'll look at that particular notice letter, I did have one additional person on there, Barnett properties, which is on the exhibit to the notice letter.
 - Q. (By Mr. Bruce) Mr. Bell, you did not attempt to seek to pool them at this time; they have signed a ratification, have they?

1 Α. Yes, sir, they have signed. 2 MR. BRUCE: Okay, so that was just a surplus 3 notice. And once again, Mr. Examiner, Exhibit 5 is just 4 5 simply the affidavit of publication of the notice of the 6 pooling published in the Carlsbad newspaper. 7 Q. (By Mr. Bruce) Especially with respect to the 8 first pooling, Mr. Bell, there were very few good addresses that you had; is that correct? 9 Yes, that's correct. 10 Α. And --11 Q. In some cases I never had an address at all. 12 Α. And the notices that were mailed out, or letters, 13 Q. were mailed to the last or best address that you had for 14 these parties? 15 That's correct. 16 Α. In each case, were Exhibits 1 through 5 in each 17 Q. matter prepared by you or under your supervision or 18 19 compiled from company business records? 20 Yes, sir, they were. Α. And in your opinion, are the granting of Chi 21 Q. Energy's Applications in the interest of conservation and 22 the prevention of waste? 23 Yes, sir. 24 Α.

Mr. Examiner, I would move the

MR. BRUCE: And at this point, Mr. Examiner, I 9 10 would pass the witness. 11 EXAMINER BROOKS: Very good. 12 **EXAMINATION** BY EXAMINER BROOKS: 13 Let's see, in the first, 12,879, the west half of 14 Q. Section 4, there are two wells, the Heavy Harry State Com 15 Number 1 and the Heavy Harry State Com Number 2; is that 16 17 correct? Yes, sir, that's correct. 18 Α. Are those both completed in the Morrow? 19 Q. I believe that they are, yes, sir. 20 Α. And what is --21 Q. Well, you know, I don't know that for a fact. 22 Α. know that the Heavy Harry Com Number 2 was a Morrow well. 23 24 EXAMINER BROOKS: Right. Mr. Examiner, I did look at the well 25 MR. BRUCE:

files, and they are completed in the Morrow.

- Q. (By Examiner Brooks) Okay. Well, my question here -- Well, let me go on, then, to the next one. The north half of Section 10, that well is -- I think I got the name of that well from the com agreement here.
 - A. It's called the Hiawatha Federal Com Number 1.
- Q. Okay, hold on a second. Let me get my paperwork complete here. Hiawatha 10 Federal Com Number 10, correct?
 - A. That's correct.
 - Q. And is that also a Morrow well?
- 11 A. Yes, sir.

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- Q. Are there any plans to drill an infill well in that unit?
- A. I can't answer that, sir, I don't --
- Q. Okay. And the third one, then, is -- in 12,881, what is the name of that well?
- 17 A. That is the Coal Train 10 Federal Com Number 1.
- 18 Q. Coal Train 10 Federal Com Number 1?
- 19 A. Yes, sir.
- 20 Q. And that is also a Morrow completion?
- 21 A. Yes, sir, I believe so.
- Q. And I assume you again do not know if there's any plans to drill an infill well in that unit?
- A. I do not know, no.
- 25 EXAMINER BROOKS: Okay. I think that's all I

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have.
