
Ladies and Gentlemen:

This letter is to advise you that EOG Resources, Inc. has filed the enclosed application with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division seeking the pooling of all mineral interests from the surface through the top 100 feet of the Mississippian Chester formation in Section 30, Township 15 South, Range 35 East, NMPM, Lots 3 and 4, E/2 SW/4 and SE/4 (S/2 Equivalent), Lea County, New Mexico. EOG proposes to dedicate the referenced pooled spacing units to its John's Hopper "30" Well No. 2 to be drilled at a standard gas well location 1980 feet from the South line and 880 feet from the West line of said Section 30.

This application has been set for hearing before a Division Examiner on September 19, 2002. You are not required to attend this hearing, but as an owner of an interest that may be affected by this application, you may appear and present testimony. Failure to appear at that time and become a party of record will preclude you from challenging the matter at a later date.

Parties appearing in cases are required by Division Rule 1208.B to file a Prehearing Statement three days in advance of a scheduled hearing. This statement must include: the names of the parties and their attorneys; a concise statement of the case; the names of all witnesses the party will call to testify at the hearing; the approximate time the party will need to present its case; and identification of any procedural matters that are to be resolved prior to the hearing.

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
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
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
