5 compulsory pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico.

7 MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, Jim Bruce of Santa Fe,
8 representing the Applicant. I just have a short statement.

9 EXAMINER BROOKS: Are there any other
10 appearances? You may proceed.

11 MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, this case was presented
12 five weeks ago at a Division Hearing. All evidence was
13 presented. There was a glitch in the advertising, so the
14 case was readvertised for today's date. I have nothing
15 further to submit.

16 EXAMINER BROOKS: Okay, refresh my recollection.
17 What was omitted from the advertisement?

18 MR. BRUCE: What was omitted from the advertising
19 is that the well is at an unorthodox oil well location, and
20 that is reflected in the new advertisement. However, we do
21 not seek approval for the unorthodox oil well location at
22 this time. It merely is reflected in the advertisement.

23 EXAMINER BROOKS: So the order that you're
24 seeking would simply say that you can constitute the unit,
25 and then you would have to apply separately for the

1 nonstandard location?

2 MR. BRUCE: That is correct.

3 EXAMINER BROOKS: Okay, very good.

4 If there's nothing further, Case Number 12,928
5 will be taken under advisement.
