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1 WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at 9:00 a.m.: 2 3 CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: Okay, we'll call this meeting to order. This is an Oil Conservation Commission 4 hearing. It's Friday, December 13th, 2002, shortly after 5 6 9:00 a.m. We're in Porter Hall in Santa Fe, New Mexico, 7 and all three Commissioners are present this morning. We have some catch-up work to do on minutes of 8 the last several meetings. We had so many in October and 9 10 November that we got behind on adoption of the minutes, but we do have four sets of minutes to review and approve. 11 The first is for the Commission Hearing held on 12 October 21st and 22nd, 2002. We also have the minutes of 13 14 the hearing held on October 25th, 2002, the minutes of the 15 hearing held on October 29th through the 31st, 2002, and 16 the minutes of the hearing held by the Commission on 17 November 22nd, 2002. And Commissioners, have you had a chance to 18 review these minutes? 19 COMMISSIONER BAILEY: Yes, I've had a chance, and 20 21 I move that we adopt them. 22 COMMISSIONER LEE: Second. 23 CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: All in favor say aye. 24 COMMISSIONER BAILEY: Aye. 25 COMMISSIONER LEE: Aye.

CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: Aye. And I will sign those on behalf of the Commission.

So a couple of announcements I need to make for the record.

We have a couple of cases that we do to plan to take action in this year, but it will not be today. We will continue these cases to a special Commission meeting that will be held at 9:00 a.m. on Thursday, December 19th.

And those cases are Case 12,734 -- this is the Application of Richardson Operating Company to establish a special "infill well" area within the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool as an exception from Rule 4 of the special rules for this pool in San Juan County, New Mexico -- and also Case 12,897 -- this is the Application of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division through the Environmental Bureau Chief for the adoption of amendments to Division Rule 118 -- we need to consider a couple of clerical corrections to the text of the Rule that was adopted on November 22nd. But as I said, we'll do both of those cases next Thursday.

And then we also had a couple of cases on the agenda that will be continued to the Commission's hearing in January, and those are Cases 12,792 -- it's the Application of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division for an order requiring Kelly H. Baxter to properly plug seven wells in Lea County, New Mexico -- and Case 12,828, the

Application of David H. Arrington Oil and Gas, Inc., for compulsory pooling in Lea County, New Mexico. Both of those will be heard in January.

CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: And that leaves us with one item of business today, and that is Case 12,935, the Application of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division to amend Rules 303.B, 309.B, Rule 309.C, and to make conforming amendments to Rule 303.A and 309.A.

And we took testimony in this matter at the Commission Hearing on November 22nd. We left the record open for additional comments until -- I'm drawing a blank on the date. It was the --

believe we got one additional comment, then, from Marathon during that time period. They sent an e-mail note in support of the Rule. And we did also, I believe, have the staff talk with the staff of the Land Office in the meantime, to make sure that the Land Office staff was comfortable with the changes that the Commission requested at the November 22nd hearing.

So there is a draft order in front of you,

Commissioners. Have you had a chance to review that draft?

1 COMMISSIONER BAILEY: Yes, I have, and I move 2 that we adopt it. 3 COMMISSIONER LEE: Second. CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: All in favor say aye. 4 COMMISSIONER BAILEY: 5 Aye. 6 COMMISSIONER LEE: 7 CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: So that's a pretty simple matter there. 8 9 I would like to say -- and the Order reflects 10 what I'm about to say -- we do appreciate the work of the 11 work group that was convened to review the surface 12 commingling Rules and suggest changes, and in particular 13 I'd like to thank Mr. Ezeanyim and Mr. Brooks for their 14 work on getting this proposal in order and ready for 15 adoption by the Commission. Thank you very much. Where is that version of the -- Oh, it's this 16 17 I was thinking that was the draft. We just need to 18 sign it at this point. 19 Okay, so that work is complete, and we'll ask the 20 staff to have this Rule published in the Register. 21 I believe that's everything that we had for today. Florene, is that right? 22 23 MS. DAVIDSON: Right. 24 CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: So entertain a motion to 25 adjourn.
