STATEMENT OF CASE

APPLICANT

Applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interests from the surface to the base of the Morrow formation under the following acreage in Section 1, Township 16 South, Range 34 East: Lots 1, 2, 7, 8, 9, 10, 15, and 16 to form a standard 328.34-acre E/2 gas spacing and proration unit for all formations or pools spaced on 320 acres within this vertical extent, which presently include but are not necessarily limited to the Undesignated Townsend-Morrow Gas Pool; the NE/4 to form a standard 160-acre spacing and proration unit for all formations or pools spaced on 160 acres within this vertical extent; the E/2 NE/4 to form a standard 80-acre oil spacing and proration unit for any and all formations or pools spaced on 80 acres within this vertical extent; and the NE/4 NE/4 to form a standard 40-acre spacing and proration unit for any and all formations or pools spaced on 40 acres within this vertical extent. These spacing and proration units are to be dedicated to Applicant's proposed Lovington Federal No. 1 Well to be drilled at a standard location in the NE/4 of said Section 1. Also to be considered will the cost of drilling and completing said well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of Applicant as operator of the well and a charge for risk involved in drilling said well.

This case seeks the pooling of the same acreage as is the subject of case No. 12942, which was heard by the Division on October 10, 2002, in which David H. Arrington Oil & Gas, Inc. ("Arrington"), is the Applicant, and in which Arrington seeks to be named operator of the proposed well. The same well location is proposed in this case and in case No. 12942, and Applicant seeks pooling of the same formations as sought by Arrington in Case No. 12942.
