Yates Petroleum Corporation et al hereby protests Devon's proposal to drill a vertical well at the unorthodox location of 810' FSL & 350' FEL in Section 8-T22S-R24E. Yates is the interest owner of the adjacent Section 9-T22S-R24E. Yates objects for two reasons:

- 1) All other wells in the Indian Basin Upper Penn Associated Pool are legally spaced.
- 2) Deviated wells are common in this area. Several operators, including Devon, have bottom hole locations deviated 2,000' or more from the surface location. Devon could easily deviate this well 310' west to the legal location.

The subject well is actually being permitted as a deviated well with a legal bottom hole location even though Devon hopes to drill vertically. It is not necessary for the well to produce 350' from Yates' lease line. In an effort to protect correlative rights, Yates objects to Devon's application.
