

PROPOSED ADVERTISEMENT

Case 12996:

Application of BP America Production Company for compulsory pooling, San Juan County, New Mexico. Applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interests from the base of the Pictured Cliffs formation to the top of the Dakota formation underlying the following described acreage in Section 24, Township 29 North, Range 12 West, NMPM: The SW $\frac{1}{4}$ to form a standard 160-acre gas spacing and proration unit for all formations and/or pools developed on 160 acre spacing within that vertical extent, including the Undesignated Otero-Chacra Gas Pool; and the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ to form a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit for all formations and/or pools developed on 40 acre spacing within that vertical extent. The units are to be dedicated to applicant's Crawford Gas Unit "B" Well No. 1, to be re-completed at an orthodox gas well location/unorthodox oil well location in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 24. Also to be considered will be the cost of re-completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well, and a charge for the risk involved in re-completing the well. The well units are located approximately 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ miles west of Bloomfield, New Mexico.
