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STATEMENT OF CASE

APPLICANT

Applicant in the above-styled cause seeks an exception to Division Rule 104.C.(2)(b) to permit the simultaneous dedication of the following wells to an existing 292.32-acre spacing and proration unit in the Morrow formation, South Empire-Morrow Gas Pool, comprised of the N/2 of irregular Section 7, Township 17 South, Range 29 East, NMPM:

A. Warp Speed A "7" Federal Com Well No. 1 located at a standard gas well location 1980 feet from the North line and 800 feet from the West line (Unit F) of Section 7 to produce the Middle and Lower Morrow Sands, and

B. Warp Speed "7" Federal Com Well No. 2 located at a previously approved unorthodox surface location 1980 feet from the North line and 525 feet from the West line of Section 7 (NSL- _____) and a standard bottomhole location in the Lower Morrow Sand at a point 1980 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the West line, to produce the Lower Morrow Sand.

Said area is located approximately 7 miles Northwest of Loco Hills, New Mexico.


