My dear Bobi

Thank you for your kind letter of August 29 in which you raised an interesting point. In so far as the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission is concerned, the order of suspension of production of crude petroleum was for the prevention of waste. Our statute, Section 2, Sub-section c, provides that production in excess of reasonable market demands constitutes waste. I am aware of the provisions of the Interstate Oil Compact, which authorize the limitation of production for the purpose of prevention of waste.

With all the foregoing in minimized issuance by the Commission of its emergency order for suspension was for the express purpose of preventing waste, insmuch as it was quite apparent that there was on the market an excess in production over and above reasonable market demand.


