New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission,

Gentlemen:

On behalf of Mr. Neil H. Wills of Carlsbad, New Mexico, and ourselves, we respectfully request that the wells in the Barber Area, Eddy County, New Mexico, (being asphaltic base production), be allowed to produce 100 barrels per day for the following reasons, to-wit:

✓ We have entered into a contract with Mr. Neil H. Wills for the purchase of all of his asphaltic base crude oil for our refinery requirements at Artesia, N.M. Our requirements are 1500 barrels daily of this type of crude and unless the allowable of the wells in question is increased to 100 barrels per day, we will have insufficient crude to operate our asphalt plant and maintain deliveries of asphalt and road oils to the U. S. Army Engineers for air base projects throughout New Mexico. For your information, we have contracts direct with the U. S. Engineers and with prime contractors for them for asphalt and road oils in quantities that will require the processing of at least 1500 barrels of asphaltic base crude oil per day at our refinery.

The daily total of asphaltic base crude oil available, taking into consideration the increased allowable requested hereby, to us is approximately 1500 barrels and no additional oil can be procured in the State of New Mexico to augment this total.

If this special allowable is granted it will not result in physical waste to the reservoir in question.

All parties at interest have consented to the proposed increase in production requested.

We are submitting letters from interested parties in support of this application.
