On behalf of Mr. Neil H. Wills of Carlsbad, New Lexico, and ourselves, we respectfully request that the wells in the Barber Area, Eddy County, New Mexico, (being asphaltic base production), be allowed to produce 100 barrels per day for the following reasons, to-wit:

Me have entered into a contract with Mr.
Reil M. Mills for the purchase of all of his asphaltic
base crude oil for our refinery requirements at Artesia,
N.M. Our requirements are 1500 barrels daily of this
type of crude and unless the allowable of the wells in
question is increased to 100 barrels per day, we will
have insufficient crude to operate our asphalt plant
and maintain deliveries of asphalt and road oils to the
U. S. Army Engineers for air base projects throughout
New Mexico. For your information, we have contracts
direct with the U. S. Engineers and with prime contractors
for them for asphalt and road oils in quantities that
will require the processing of at least 1500 barrels
of asphaltic base crude oil per day at our refinery.
