IT IS THEREFORE ORDERD:

That the respective units of proration within the West Lusk, Barber, East Lusk Fields, and the newly discovered Benson Area, all within Eddy County, producing asphaltic base crude oil, shall be allowed to produce over and above the current allowable, insofar as such units are capable and insofar as such may be done without waste, up to 100 barrels of crude oil daily for purchase by the applicant for the purpose of supplying the United States Army Engineers with asphalt and road oils to be used in the construction of airbase projects in New Mexico and Texas and the New Mexico Highway Department for paving of roads where Federal approval of such paving is granted; provided, however, as follows:

A. That the New Mexico Asphalt and Refining Company first purchase the current allowable of crude oil of similar types produced in southeastern New Mexico and tendered to such purchaser.

- B. That the New Mexico Asphalt and Refining Company make use of such excess allowable strictly for the purpose above named.
- 2. That this order shall be effective retroactive beginning with December 1, 1942, and shall continue for the duration of the present War Emergency and for six months thereafter.
