Dear Sire

The attached subsurface map of the Southeast Vacuum Area, Lea County, New Mexico, is contoured with a centour interval of 100 feet on top of the Cloud Chief (Tansill) formation of Permian age.

The subsurface structure shown sentering in Section 17, Township 18 South, Range 36 East is largely hypothetical as only a few scattered tests have been drilled in the area. This structural interpretation is based for the most part on the indicated presence of a structural axis extending southeastward from the southeast part of the Vacuum field in Township 17 South, Range 35 East to the northern portion of the Monument field in Township 19 South, Ranges 36 and 37 East. The indicated axis parallels the axis of the Hobbs structure ten miles to the east and also parallels the structural trend extending from the Hobbs field northwestward to the South Lovington field.

A 5500 foot test to be lecated 660 feet from the north and east lines of Section 17, Township 18 South, Range 36 East, Lea County, New Mexico is proposed to test the structure. This depth will test the San Andres formation of the Permian which produces in the Vacuum field five miles to the northwest.

Pirst, as to the Agreement.

"1. LIMS: This agreement is made subject to Chapter Simty Hire, New hexico Statutes Annotated, 1941, and Chapter Eighty-eight of the Lew Kimico Session have of 1943". That chapter relates to insense skylum and State prison pension matters. Undoubtedly what was intended to be used is Chapter 77, have of New Mexico 1935, our basic oil conservation law.

The Agreement seems to make no provision for any development program other than the one well in Section 5.

The purpose of a potition is to set out matters clearly.

If reason of the foregoing matters as well as mis-nomer in the caption is in recommerded that the petition be revised. Judge Seth would have a clear idea has to to this.



CERTIFICATE OF APPROVAL SOUTHEAST VACUUM UNIT

The undersigned, Commissioner of Public Lands of the State of New Mexico, having this day examined an agreement for the cooperative or unit operation and development of a prospective oil or gas field or area, which agreement is entitled, "The Southeast Vacuum Unit, Lea County, New Mexico," and embracing lands in Sections 8, 9, 16 and 17, Township 18 South, Range 36 East, as set out in said agreement, entered into between Stanolind Oil and Gas Company and The Pure Oil Company, to which agreement this Certificate is attached; and

WHEREAS, upon examination thereof, the Commissioner finds:

- a. That such agreement will tend to promote the conservation of oil and gas and the better utilization of reservoir energy in said field;
- b. That under the operations proposed, the State will receive its fair share of the recoverable oil or gas in place under its lands in the area affected;
- c. That the agreement is in other respects for the best interest of the State;
- d. That the agreement provides for the unit operation of the field, for the allocation of production, and the sharing of proceeds from a part of the area covered by the agreement on an acreage basis as specified in the agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of the authority conferred upon me by Chapter 88 of the Laws of the State of New Mexico, 1943, approved April 14, 1943, I, the undersigned, Commissioner of Public Lands of the State of New Mexico, for the purpose of more properly conserving the oil and gas resources of the State, do hereby consent to and approve the said agreement, as to the lands of the

State of New Mexico included in said Southeast Vacuum Unit Agreement, and subject to all the provisions of the aforesaid Chapter 88 of the Laws of the State of New Mexico, 1943.
