PROCERDINGS

After being sworm to tell the truth, the whole truth and nothing but the truth, the witness testified as follows:

By JUDGE SETH - Representing the Stanolind Oil & Gas Company.

Please state your name.

MR. HOEY: William T. Rosy.

JUDGE SETE: What is your profession?

MR. HOMY: Petroleum geelegist.

JUDGE SHIE: State in brief your training and experience.

MR. HOWY: 30 years experience in geological work with major eil companies.

JUDGS SETH: Graduate of what cellege?

MR. HOMY: Missouri School of Mines.

JUDGE SETE: By whom are you now employed?

MR. HOET: Standlind 011 and Cas Company.

JUDGE SETE: New long?

MR. HOMY: One year.

JUDGE STEE Are you familiar with this area included in this unit agreement?

MR. HOMY: Yes cir, I am.

JUDGE SETH: (Presenting map) Does the heavy area on this map indicate the outside boundary of the proposed unit area?

MR. HOMY: Yes sir.

JUDGE SETH: The yellow?

MR. HOMY: The acreage owned by the Stanolind Oil and Gas Company.

JUDGE SHITE: The black?

MR. HOMY: Pure Oil Company.

JUDGE SETH: The Pure Oil Company and Stanolind Oil and Gas Company joined?

MR. HORY: Yes sir-

JUDGE SETH: 80 acres Gulf, 160 Magnelia, have they signed the unit agreement?

MR. HORY: No, they haven't.

JUDGE SETE: It provides they can come in doesn't it?

MR. HOEY: Yes eir.

JUDGE SETE: Where is the proposed well to be drilled to test this wmit?

MR. HORY: WE corner of Section 17.

GOVERNOR DEAT SEY: Just taking four sections here?

JUDGE SETH: Yes, the heavy marks around them.

GOVERNOR DEMISSY: The yellow also owned by Stanolind?

MR. HOMY: Yes sir.

SUDGE SETH: The contour lines on that map, on what are they based?

MR. Home: Contour on top of the tinsel formation.

JUDGE SETE: What general geological formation is that?

MR. HOMY: Permanent age.

JUDGE SETH: How far below the surface?

MR. HOSY: 23 or 24 hundred feet.

JUDGE SITH: On what is that contour line based?

MR. HOWY: The iry holes and the control we have in the areas.

JUDGE SETE: The contour lines represent the best geological information?

MR. HONY: Yes sir.

JUDGE SETH: Do you believe this is a geological unit?

MR HOEY: I certainly do.

JUDGE SETH: One that should be properly developed as a unit?

JUDGE SETA: All the land in the proposed unit owned by the State?

KR. HOEY: Yes sir.

JUDGE SETH: All state leases, no federal or private?

MR. HOSY: No sir.

JUEGS SETH: Do you believe the development of that area as a unit will increase the production and conserve reservoir energy?

MR. HOSY: Yes sir.

JUDGE SETTE: A conservation measure?

MR. HOUY: Yes sir.

JUDGE SOTH: Has an agreement been signed between the Stanolind and Pure Oil Companies?

MR. HOEY: Yes sir.

JUDGE SETH: Do you have a photostatic copy of it?

MR. HOSY: We do.

JUDGE SETH: Present photostatic copy of agreement in evidence (Exhibit No. 2)

(Mr. Livingston called my attention to the fact that in referring to laws, reference is made pensions for employees of the state insane asylum and state prison and should be Oil Conservation Commission Act. Chapter 75. Laws of 1935.)

Do you know whether the Gulf and Magnolia were given an opportunity to sign?

MR. HOEY: You sir.

JUDGE SHTH: The agreement provides they may later join? MR. HOET: Yes sir.

JUDGE SEEM: Whele area of four sections the entire participating area under the unit plan?

MR. HOWY: You sir.

JUDGS SHTE: No other area other than that?

Mi. HOSY: That is all.

JUDGE SEEK: Have you any further statements you care to make with regeat to the advisability of this?

MR. HOMT: Only that we intend drilling this well to a depth deep enough to test.

JUDGE SETH: The agreement provides you drill 5500 feet, is that a proper test in your epinion?

MR. HOST: It is.

JUDGE SETH: If after a test it indicates that the unit area should be enlarged, the contract provides for that?

MR. HOHY: That is right.

GOVERNOR DEMFERT: Did the Gulf and Magnolia indicate they would not sign the agreement?

MR. HOHY: The acreage ewned in the unit is owned by Spanolind and Pure.

That owned by Magnelia is in another unit and held by production at this time.

JUDGE SETH: They prefer to mucht the outcome of this well?
MR. HOEY: Tes sir.

GOVERNOR DEMPSHY: What about the Gulf?

MR. HOST: They are in another unit.

MR. KELLY: He other unit, you mean another well?

MR. HOMY: Yes eir.

MR. RELLY: Your map shows your contours that embrace this unityou have another $1\frac{1}{2}$ sections of land, why wasn't it included in this unit?

MR. HOSY: We wanted to start on a small unit.

MR. KELLY: Isn't the theory of unitization to try to unitize the structure if you can. Would she Stanolind have any opposition if that 12 sections was included.

MR. HOEY: I wouldn't think they would.

MR. KELLY: That is all.

GOVERNOR MILES: In the yellow area - what is that?

GOVERNOR EMEPSET: The Standlind and Pure own these sections in it.

JUDGE SETH: I might state the matter was submitted to Governor

Miles, and we were advised they approved it as to form, but

wanted to await the outcome of satisfaction by the Cil Commission

before the Land Gemmission approved it.

GOVERNOR DEMPSET: We will take the matter under advisement and

inform the interested parties at a later date.
