NOW, on this 12<sup>th</sup> day of February, 1945, the Commission having before it for consideration the testimony adduced at the hearing of said case and being fully advised in the premises;


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

SECTION 1. That the Stanolind Oil and Gas Company is hereby granted an unorthodox spacing for the following well:

Stanolind Oil and Gas Company - W. S. Capps No. 10X in the NESE, Section 3, Township 19S, Range 38E, Hobbs Field -- with the following footage location: 1980 feet North of the South line and 1293 feet West of the East line of ~~said NESE~~ of said section.
