The undersigned herewith submits its formal application to drill the following wells for oil and gas to be located at irregular locations as follows in Section 1, Township 17 North, Range 9 West, McKinley County, State of New Mexico:

- Well No. 39 to be located in the SW1SW1NE1 of said Section, 330 east of the center section line and 330 North of the center line of the Section.
- Well No. 40 to be located in the NE1SW1 of said Section, 1955' east of the west line of the section and 1955' north of the south line of the Section.
- Well No. 41 to be located in S\frac{1}{2}NW\frac{1}{2} of said Section, 1312 east of the west section line and 3000 north of the south section line.
- Well No. 42 to be located in the S½NW½ of said section, 1312 east of the west Section line and 3660 north of the south section line of the Section.
- Well No. 43 to be located in the  $N_2$ SW $_2$  of said section, 1312 east of the west line and 2340 north of the south section line.
- Well No. 44 to be located in the  $\frac{N_2}{2}SW_2$  of said section, 1312' east of the west line and 1680' north of the south line of the section.

- Well No. 45 to be located in the \$\frac{1}{2}\$\$\frac{1}{2}\$\$\frac{1}{2}\$\$ of said section, 1312 east of the west line and 1020 North of the south line of said section.
- Well No. 46 to be located in the  $\mathbb{E}_{2}^{1}SW_{4}^{1}$  of said section, 1972' east of the west line and 1295' north of the south line of said Section.
- Well No. 47 to be located in the N\frac{1}{2}NW\frac{1}{2} of said section, 330\frac{1}{2} south of the north line and ll88\frac{1}{2} east of the west line of said section.

The reason for this application is that during the early days of the field there were a few wells drilled on irregular locations. Therefore, it will be necessary to continue this drilling pattern in order to save waste and conserve oil and effect proper drainage of the reservoir.

#### PROCEEDINGS

(After being duly sworn Mr. Ray McLaughlin testified as follows)

Ray McLaughlin, President of the Petroleum Products Refining and Producing Company, who own and operates the Hospah lease in McKinley County.

MR. \*\*Correction\*: Located in Section 36, range 9, township 18, section 1, range 9, township 17, the Petroleum Products Refining and Producing Company are the sole owners of the structure and have made application to the Commission for permission to drill from unorthodox locations. The reason is that along in the area on irregular locations there were some wells drilled due to some surveying errors which also was part of the cause of the wells in the field. They were not drilled in the exact ten acre spacings, in order to get the proper drainage of the field, we made application to P.A.W. for ten acre spacings, which was approved. My application to the Commission for permission of these ten acre spacings, would like to locate them where they are equally divided and proper spacings in the field. No other parties are interested in the field.

I present this map as "Exhibit A", showing the proposed location.

GOVERNOR DEMPSEY: Federal or State land.

MR. McGLOTHLIN: Section 36 State and 1 Santa Fe land. There would be no locations which would interfere with royalty interests of either one. Happens to be all Santa Fe property.

GOVERNOR DEMPSEY: You have the approval of the P.W.A.?

MR. McGLOTHLIN: Yes we have.

GOVERNOR DEMPSEY: Any objections from anybody here in reference to this proposal?
