ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at Santa Fe, New Mexico, at ten o'clock A.M., June 7, 1946, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission".

NOW, on this 7th day of June, 1946, the Commission having before it for consideration the testimony adduced at the hearing of said case and being fully advised in the premises;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:


SECTION 1. Order 485 as amended by Order 595 is hereby further amended by the addition of a new section as follows:


"IX. Back allowable shall be permitted beginning with December 1, 1945, but shall not exceed the maximum daily rate of back allowable currently prescribed by the Commission. Said nomination shall show back allowable in total barrels separately from the current allowable. A separate or additional column shall be provided in said schedule showing the number of barrels daily of back allowable for each proration unit in order to distinguish back allowable from current allowable shown in said schedule as computed by said formula".

SECTION 2. The order herein shall become effective July 1, 1946.
