LOCATION IS 1594 FEET SOUTH OF THE NORTH LINE
AND 2411 FEET WEST OF THE EAST LINE OF SAID
SECTION.

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at Santa Fe, New Mexico, at ten o'clock
A.M., June 7, 1946, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico,
hereinafter referred to as the "Commission".

NOW, on this 7th day of June, 1946, the Commission having before it for
consideration the testimony adduced at the hearing of said case and being fully
advised in the premises;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

SECTION 1. I. K. Westbrook is hereby granted an irregular oil and gas
well location for his Santa Fe Pacific Railroad Company Well No. 1, in the
SW NE Section 22-20N-11W, N.M.P.M., McKinley County, New Mexico. Said irregular
location being 1594 feet South of the North line and 2411 feet West of the
East line of said section.

SECTION 2. The order herein shall be effective June 7, 1946.
