SECTION 1. I. K. Westbrook is hereby granted an irregular oil and gas well location for his Santa Fe Pacific Railroad Company Well No. 1, in the SW NE Section 22-20N-11W, N.M.P.M., McKinley County, New Mexico. Said irregular location being 1594 feet South of the North line and 2411 feet West of the East line of said section.

SECTION 2. The order herein shall be effective June 7, 1946.
