Dear Sir:

This is in answer to your letter of November 4th regarding a gas well located near your property line in Section 30, T29N - RLLE.

This well is being drilled by the Jenkins Drilling Company on the Cassidy lease. According to a survey plat submitted with the Notice of Intention to Drill, this well is located 990 feet north of the south line and approximately 660 feet west of the east line of Section 19, Township 29 North, Range 11 West. Since this survey was made by a registered land surveyor we believe it is correct.

As long as this well is 990 feet north of the south property line it is within the legal limits set by the Commission. There is nothing unorthodox about the location except the 160 acres was not in the shape of a square, and it was impossible to locate the required 990 feet from the east or west line.

I hope this will answer your question in a satisfactory manner.



Gentlemen:

I am a resident of Albuquerque, New Mexico and own some property in San Juan County, Near Bloomfield, New Mexico.

On a recent trip to that area, I noticed that someone is drilling an oil well near my privately controlled land in Section 30, T. 29 N., R. 11 E. I contacted Mr. Al Greer in Aztec regarding this, and he informed me that this was an unorthodox location granted by the Commission to Mr. G. R. Cassidy to drill a well in the $SE_4^1SE_4^1$ of Section 19, above township and range. In the hearing on the granting of the right for him to drill this well, it stated that he was to drill this well 990 feet from the south section line, and 660 feet west of the east line of Section 19. I believe that if a check is made, you will find that this well is only some 200 or 300 feet from my property line. Knowing that others have drilled wells almost entirely surrounding the Cassidy place, I feel that Mr. Cassidy should have had the right to drill a well on his property. However, I do not feel that I should be the one who should suffer from the allowanve of this unorthodox location.
