IN THE MATTER OF THE TWIN OIL CORPORATION FOR AN ORDER UNITIZING THE NORTHEAST QUARTER OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER (NEINE) OF SECTION 4, TOWNSHIP 22 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, N.M.P.M., LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO, OR IN THE ALTERNATIVE, AUTHORIZING THE DRILLING OF A WELL OR WELLS UPON THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED LAND: BEGINNING AT A POINT 660 FEET WEST OF THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER (NEINE NEINE) OF SAID SECTION, THENCE ON A DIRECT LINE WEST 210 FEET, THENCE ON A DIRECT LINE SOUTH 420 FEET, THENCE ON A DIRECT LINE EAST 210 FEET, CONTAINING APPROXIMATELY 2 ACRES OF LAND, MORE OR LESS, AND FIXING AN ALLOWABLE THEREFOR.
