

#### APPLICATION

COMES HOW Rufus G. Clay, an individual, of Fort Worth, Texas, operating in New Mexico from field office in Hobbs, New Mexico, and respectfully represents to the Oil Conservation Commission of the State of New Mexico that he has completed the Geo. Etz Well #1, in the SMSW Sec. 27, T. 235, R. 36E, N.M.P.M. Lea County, New Mexico. This well is producing from the Seven Rivers Formation from an interval 3373' through 3393', through tubing with packer set at 3364'. 5 1/2" casing is set at 2990'.

Applicant further represents that a high pressure gas zone exists at an approximate depth of 301C' in the Yates Formation which gas is at present separated from the producing oil zone by formation packer, and that it is practical and economically feasible to produce this gas through the annulus between casing and tubing with proper casing head connection.

WHEREFORE, applicant ask that permission be granted to re-complete this well to produce from both the Yates Gas Zone and the Seven Rivers Oil Zone.

Plat is attached hereto showing location of wells in vicinity, copy of which plat and this application has been furnished to all offset operators.
