

Gentlemen:

At the conclusion of the hearing held on April 27 on Case No. 219 involving a request for exception to the General Rules by Gulf Oil Corporation, it was requested that a list of 32 wells in the vicinity of the town of Eunice be submitted to the Commission and to Mr. R. S. Christie of the Amerada Petroleum Company at Fort Worth. For your information I am attaching the list of 32 wells requested. A copy of this list has been furnished Mr. Christie.

Since the time of the hearing we have received approval to proceed with the installation of additional facilities at our Eunice Gasoline Plant which will add adequate capacity to handle the volume of gas produced from these 32 wells. Construction should be started in the near future and the program completed within six months.

There was one item of interest of which I feel sure you are aware but which we did not wish to present for fear of misinterpretation by some of those present at the hearing. As you know, our plant is connected to a large number of leases in the general Eunice area and it would be possible at the present time to take all of the gas from the 32 wells listed provided we turned out a like volume of gas from wells flowing naturally. This would have permitted us to be within the rules so far as the 32 wells are concerned, but such practice would be neither a profitable nor a conservation measure since the naturally flowing wells from which gas would have to be vented have a considerably higher gasoline and LPG content than the gas from the 32 wells. If the gas from naturally flowing wells was vented substantial quantities of gasoline and LPG products would have been vented and permanently lost.

If there is anything further in this case on which you wish information I shall be glad if you will advise.
