Reference is made to Order No. R-13, Case No. 213, issued March 15, 1950, by the Oil Conservation Commission. The description of the Bloomfield oil pool contained in that order is in error to the extent of including the \mathbb{W}_{2}^{1} sec. 13 and \mathbb{W}_{2}^{1} sec. 24, T. 29 N., R. 11 W.

The description of the Bloomfield oil pool was correctly included in the recommendations of the Northwest New Mexico Nomenclature Committee revised March 22, 1949, and approved by the Oil Conservation Commission June 1, 1949, to include the following land:

You will note that the lands in sections 13 and 24 have been transposed in Order No. R-13 as to the portion of the sections and as to the township.

Accordingly, Order No. R-13 should be amended as to the Bloomfield pool by deleting the $W_{\overline{z}}$ sec. 13 and $W_{\overline{z}}$ sec. 24, T. 29 N., R. 11 W., and in lieu thereof adding the $E_{\overline{Z}}^{1}$ section 13 and $E_{\overline{Z}}^{1}$ section 24, T. 29 N., R. 12 W.

The lands in question were added to the definition of the Bloomfield pool to include the Carroll and Cornell well No. 5 in the NE NE Sec. 13, T. 29 N., R. 12 W., which produced a total of 512 barrels from the Farmington sand. The well was subsequently deepened and completed as a gas producer from the Pictured Cliffs formation and is now included in the Fulcher Basin-Kutz Canyon gas pool.
