Dear Mr. Spurrier:

I wish to thank you for your favor of November 7th regarding Delhi's application, Case #236, together with your plat which describes the matter so lucidly. I hope you will pardon me if I tell you that I cannot agree that it seems like a good plan.

If you would take time to outline the wells as they would fall under the program, I think you will agree with me that the pattern in those sections would be completely out of balance, and that it would likewise interfere with the pattern in the next sections to the west. I cannot see where any injustice would be done anyone if the $N_2^{\frac{1}{2}}$ of each of these sections would be constituted a drilling unit, and the $S_2^{\frac{1}{2}}$ of each of these sections would likewise be constituted a drilling unit.

It is true that this would create drilling units of only 260 acres, instead of 300 acres which you propose, but it would harm no one, and keep the drilling pattern in the area intact. Otherwise some of these wells drilled as you propose on the W_2^1 of these sections would be jammed up against these other wells both east and west.

Inasmuch as Delhi wrote me that they were asking for a program such as I have just outlined, I would greatly appreciate your reconsidering this matter, as I think it would be best for all concerned.

In reply to your letter of November 6, in which you refer to Delhi's application, Case 236, we have not yet issued an order on this case, but the following was approved on the day of the hearing:

All of the extreme west quarter sections of townships 30 and 31 north, Range 9 west, will be communitized by 3's to form four drilling units of about 300 acres each. Enclosed please find a township plat upon which I have attempted to show in red pencil, what I mean.

The east half of each section on the west side of these two townships will necessarily become a drilling block.

In re: Case 236 - Delhi Application.

Gentlemen:

Some time ago I was advised that the hearing was to be held on October 24th relating to the above case, and understood that the application was for an order permitting the communitizing of short or narrow quarter sections on the north - south basis as they lie along the west side of Townships 30 and 31 North, Range 9 West, etc.

Inasmuch as I am the owner of the $NW\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 6 - 30 North - 9 West, I was naturally interested in this matter. My quarter section comprises only approximately 100 acres. I also received a letter from Delhi Cil Corporation advising me that they intended to drill the $N\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 6 making a unit out of that, and also the $S\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 6 making a unit out of that. In other words, there would be 260 acres in each drill block, and they suggested that I pay my proportionate share of the well which they were to drill in the $NE\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 6, and receive my proper proportion of the proceeds. I wrote them two or three times regarding this, and have never had a comprehensive reply. They have gone ahead and are drilling a gas well on the $NE\frac{1}{4}$.

Now to my amazement I have been told that at your meeting on October 24, 1950 that instead of making the N_{Ξ}^{\perp} of each section and the S_{Ξ}^{\perp} of each section separate and distinct drill blocks, there has been some new proposal whereby the E_{Ξ}^{\perp} of the section would become a drill block, and in some way which I do not understand the acreage on the west line would be made into some sort of drill blocks, which it seems to me would entirely upset the drilling pattern in the entire area and generally would make a mess of things. I am, therefore, very anxious to hear from you at once as to what the situation actually is, as I understand that you have not yet given a final decision in the matter.

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
