ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

By the Commission

This matter came on regularly for hearing at 10:00 o'clock a.m. on February 20, 1951 at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this 26th day of February 1951, the Commission having before it the testimony adduced at the hearing and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- 1. That due public notice having been given, as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of the case.
- 2. That the evidence shows conclusively that topographical conditions are such that a regular location would be difficult and expensive.
- 3. That the L. B. Lodewick No. 2 well location is upon Federal lands, and Federal officials present at the hearing interposed no objection to the proposed location.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the application of the Commission, by request of Byrd-Frost, Inc for an unorthodox location for Byrd-Frost, Inc., L. B. Lodewick No. 2 well be, and the same hereby is approved for:

Township 27 North, Range 9 West, N. M.P. M. "895 feet from the south and west lines of sec. 18"
